- Humanities 7 Honors (Honors English and Honors Social Studies) and
- Math 7 Honors**

Honors courses require high levels of **independent** and **critical thinking, analysis** and **inquiry** in a **rigorous** setting. Courses are designed to meet the needs of students who demonstrate high achievement and motivation, to prepare them for advanced coursework in high school and beyond.
